## **HURRICANE MICHAEL & DISASTER ASSISTANCE INFORMATION**

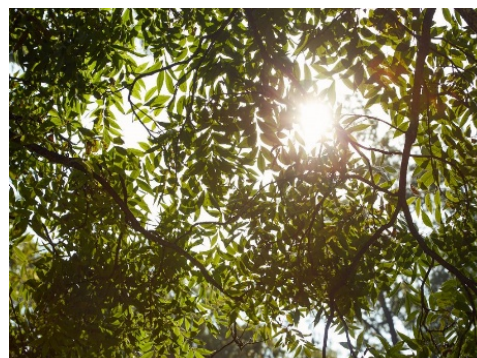
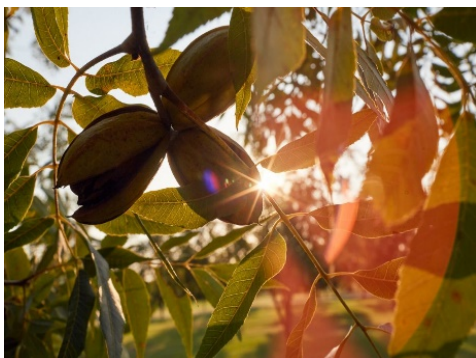
